## Academic Scholarship Contest Rules and Guidelines

### WHO IS ELIGIBLE:

1. Applicants must be graduating seniors who have all basic credits for entering 4-year college program and the intention to pursue a 4-year college program.
2. Applicants must have a current career grade point average of at least 3.25 on a 4.0 scale and a combined ACT score of at least 22.
3. Accepted applicants must attend an accredited college.
4. The parents or guardians of the students must live in a county within the certified electric territory of South Central Power Company.
5. Any applicant who has received a full ride scholarship to the school or his/her choice is **NOT** eligible for a scholarship. Definition of "Full Ride" – an award from student's selected school that covers tuition, room, board and books.
6. Applicant may apply for only ONE Operation Round Up scholarship (Academic or Technical).

### GUIDELINES:

1. Applicants must complete the official application form.
2. All applications must be typed or clearly printed to be accepted.
3. A complete high school grade transcript must accompany the application.
4. Application information must be confined to the official application form with **NO ATTACHMENTS**, other than the grade transcript.
5. All applications must be delivered to the office of Liz Bainter by **February 1, 2019**. We look forward to reviewing your application.
