Enclosed, you will find an application for funding from the South Central Power Company Foundation, a non-profit corporation organized to provide financial support to groups and organizations involved in public, charitable, educational, humanitarian and scientific purposes in the service territory of South Central Power Company.

As you prepare your application, keep these guidelines in mind:

- Grant awards are available in amounts not to exceed:
  - \$10,000 for groups and charities
  - \$ 3,000 for food pantries
  - \$ 2,000 for families
  - \$ 1,000 for individuals
- Grant awards **may not** be used for religious purposes, in support of any political candidate or issue, or for payment of electric bills.
- Grant awards to groups or charities must not be the sole source of project funding.
- A budget for the project or activity must accompany the application. Itemize all expenses that equate to the **total cost** of the project. Organizations or groups must attach a recent financial or profit/loss statement. Applications must be signed by a representative of the party filing the application.
- Grants will not be awarded to cover operating expenses.
- The Foundation will not accept applications for specific projects or events if applications for that same project or event have already been rejected twice.
- Applications must be limited to the official application form and no more than three additional pages. Please submit one-sided pages for the application and supporting documentation. Do not staple or fold the application or other pages.
- Applications will be accepted at any time but will be reviewed and awarded only four times per year. Submittal deadlines are: **March 31, June 30, September 30** and **December 31**. The Foundation Board of Directors may, at its discretion, hold unfunded applications for review during the next round of funding. All decisions of the Board of Directors are final.
- Funds must be used within one year of their award.
