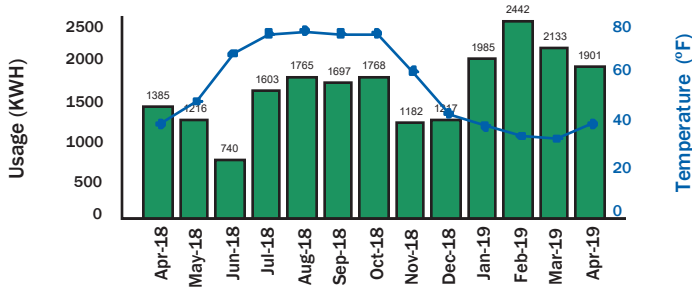

EXPLANATION OF TERMS

Read type: "Actual" read means your meter was read, while an "Estimate" means your usage was estimated based on your usage history. Estimated bills will be adjusted in the next billing cycle with an actual reading.

kWh: A measure of how much energy you're using. If you use a 100-watt light bulb for 10 hours, you use 1 kWh of electricity.

Demand Read: Demand is the maximum flow of power used at any one time at your location, measured in kW.

Consumer Charge: A fixed charge that covers some administrative and infrastructure costs incurred in delivering power and maintaining our business operations.

Distribution Charge: A variable charge covering the cost of delivering power to your location, including equipment such as wires, poles and transformers.

Generation and Transmission Charge: Covers the cost of producing power and moving it across the state or region at the transmission level.

kWh tax: A state consumption tax is collected by South Central Power and paid directly to the State of Ohio.

Operation Round Up: If you participate in Operation Round Up, your bill is rounded to the nearest dollar, with the balance distributed to the South Central Power Foundation for charitable use. You can learn more at: <http://www.southcentralpower.com/south-central-power-company-foundation>.



Prepare for summer

Summer is just around the corner. Here are three tips to make sure you are prepared for energy efficiency and savings.

- 1 Make sure your ceiling fans are spinning counterclockwise, which pushes air down and creates a cool breeze.
- 2 Change your thermostat and save! The Department of Energy estimates savings of about 1 percent annually for each degree of thermostat adjustment per 8 hours.
- 3 Ensure that your air conditioning system is operating to peak efficiency. Replace your air filter regularly and hire a qualified professional to inspect and clean your system.
